Adopt a Spot: Nature Journaling and the Ecology of Place



Driving Question

How can we, as ecologists, observe and interact with nature in order to understand our impact on the environment?

Content

This project will cover a variety of 3rd grade standards:

Major Products

Students will work with a group to "Adopt a Spot" on campus that is important to them based on their research. Students will become experts on this spot, and examine our community's impact on that spot in order to take care of it and advocate for it. Part of this process will include an individual nature journal where they will record daily outdoor observations, data collection, and scientific

drawings.

Public Presentation

Students will provide guided tours of their adopted space for other grade levels, advocating for the importance of taking responsibility for our shared natural spaces.
