
## 7<sup>th</sup> Grade PBL Inequalities In Our World



<u>Driving Question</u>: Can the student apply one variable inequalities to the world around them?

<u>Content</u>: Students will devise 6 different questions of interest, interview 6 various data samples from the different groups that they belong, (family, sports, school, etc.) and communicate their findings with 6 different inequalities. Findings must include a mathematical inequality, written word equality, and a graph. Students will create a poster with the 6 different inequalities and will be graded with a rubric that validates that the inequality represents a real-world scenario. **Standards:**
